**RE: Use of Safariland Ballistic Panels with 5.11 Uniform Outer Carrier**

Dear Mr. Hein

As specified in our Body Armor Warranty, our ballistic panels are warranted for a period of sixty (60) months (see Body Armor Warranty for details). Consistent with the terms of the warranty, Safariland will continue to support the warranty of Safariland Armor, ABA, and Second Chance ballistic panels when used in conjunction with the 5.11 Uniform Outer Carrier (s) subject to the following conditions.

- Safariland Armor, ABA, and Second Chance panels must remain in their original carriers from the factory when inserted into the 5.11 Uniform Outer Carrier (s).
- The front and rear panels must be fastened together with the Velcro straps and connected inside of the shoulder area of the 5.11 Uniform Outer Carrier carrier(s) in order to suspend the front and back ballistic panels in the proper orientation.

Please be advised that proper orientation is integral to the performance of the ballistic panels. Also, ballistic panels offer protection to only those areas that cover the body. As such, Safariland will not be responsible for the sizing, labeling or integration of the ballistic panels with the 5.11 Uniform Outer Carrier.
